

DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (INDUSTRY)



INTRODUCTION

A Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) through the industrial methods approach involves the use of existing data available at the industrial site. Prospective students are not eligible to apply if they do not have existing data. The availability of this data must be clearly stated in the portfolio submitted during the application and will be evaluated in the internal assessment.



REQUIREMENTS

1. Must have the ability to conduct independent research over a period of five (5) years at the time of application, and evidence of this capability should be translated into a portfolio.
2. Appointment of a Field Supervisor is the responsibility of the Faculty, depending on the field and research requirements.
3. Must pass five (5) Research Methodology courses as recommended by the Main Supervisor as a graduation requirement. Exemptions are allowed if the students have already passed Research Methodology courses at the Master's level only.
4. Candidates without qualifications in the field must pass prerequisite courses before commencing their studies, as stated in the latest UMPSA Graduate Studies Academic Regulations Book.
